Notice: Installation instruction must be followed. Any diversions from the installations may risk property damage and will void the warranty.


Notice: When moving your tub be sure to lift, never slide or pull, doing so may result in damage to the product or surrounding area.


PREPARE FOR INSTALLATION:



1. Remove the tub from the packaging and place on a soft cloth. (it is recommended to have two people for this step)
2. Level the tub by turning it over and rotating the feet underneath. (it is recommended to have two people for this step)
3. Fill the tub to the overflow, and check for leaks.
4. Clean and prepare the floor where you will be installing the tub.
5. Place the tub in the exact position you will be installing it. (it is recommended to have two people for this step)
6. Using a pencil, trace around the tub, marking the installation area.

INSTALLATION:

1. Determine the location of the drain pipe on the floor by measuring of the drain and waste location under the tub. (This will vary on each tub)
2. Apply a bead of silicone or adhesive to the bottom tub supports.
3. Apply a bead of tub and tile caulk around the edge of the base.
4. Carefully set the tub into position and connect the preinstalled drain to the waste water pipe.
5. Filling the tub again check for any leaks in waste connections below. (access below the floor will be necessary)
6. Wipe up any excess tub and tile caulk.
7. Apply a final bead of tub and tile caulk around the bottom edge of the tub where it meets the floor and wipe away any excess.
8. For faucet installation consult the manufacturer's instructions.



CARE GUIDE:

Care: Rinse thoroughly and use a soft cloth to wipe the product dry after each use to prevent hard water stains.

Cleaning: Soft abrasive cleaners may be used when necessary.

LIMITED WARRANTIES

Odass warrants the product to be free from defects in workmanship from the date of purchase.

These warranties extend only to the original owner/end-user for personal household use and start from the date of purchase/billing. This warranty cannot be transferred to a third party and additional limitations apply for commercial uses.

In the eventuality that a manufacturing defect appears, the owner/enduser must have in his possession, a proof of purchase as well as a proof of installation by a professional recognized by the construction industry.

Odass reserves the right to inspect on site, the defect by a representative of its choice. Any return of goods will not be accepted without the written authorization from Odass.

Odass cannot be held responsible about the defects or breaking resulting from any act of god, accident, catastrophe, abuse, negligence, improper installation/use/maintenance, intensive variation of temperature, exposures to chemicals or stains caused by different types of water such as ferrous or alkaline water, etc. The use of abrasives of any kind, gritting scraper, brushes or any other scouring object which can damage the surface of the product is to be proscribed and will cancel the present warranty.

Odass will be repaired or replaced (with a product of equal value) to her discretion of any product reported to the authorized dealer or to Odass as being defective within the warranty period. Neither the distributor, authorized Odass dealer nor any other person has been authorized to make any affirmation, representation or warranty other than those contained in the warranty; any affirmation, representation or warranty other than those contained in this warranty shall not be enforceable against Odass or any other person.

This warranty excludes any expenses related to shipping, handling and/or installation fees.

Odass cannot be held responsible for the fees of labor, wastes of time, expenses of sundries or replacement of installation material, including, but not limited to, tiles, marble, etc.

Odass reserves the right to modify this warranty at any time, it being understood that such modification will not alter the warranty conditions applicable at the time of the sale of the products in question

LIMITED WARRANTIES

Odass warrants for a period of 10 years, acrylic unit to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.

Odass warrants for a period of 10 years, shower doors to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.

Odass warrants for a period of 5 years, sanitary products (toilet, lavatories basin) to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.

Odass warrants for a period of 2 years, storage modules and vanities to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.

Odass warrants for a period of 2 years, glass mirrors to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.

Odass warrants for a period of 2 years, electrical components to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal use and service from the initial date of purchase by the owner/end-user, contractor or builder.
